



2010 CAMPER AGREEMENT

We are committed to providing each camper with a healthy, safe and fun environment. To ensure the best possible experience, this Camper Agreement (“Agreement”) outlines appropriate camper behavior. Its intention is to make families aware of camp’s primary expectations and does not assume that any child has created a heightened level of concern. In order to maintain consistency, this Agreement is mandatory for all campers – regardless of age – and parents.

In the unlikely event that a camper’s actions and/or behavior violates this Agreement, the camper may be subject to discipline, including dismissal from camp, at the parent’s expense. The decision to dismiss a camper from camp is made solely by the camp director.

I agree that:

1. I will be a positive influence on camp.
2. I will not bully or harass any camper or staff member. I understand that camp has a zero tolerance policy for such behavior.
3. I will participate in cabin clean-up, ensuring a comfortable, healthy environment.
4. I will not bring a cell phone to camp, nor will I use someone else’s cell phone at any time while camp is in session. I recognize that cell phones are a distraction to camp’s community environment. (When cell phones have been sneaked into camp, the ultimate result is often camper anxiety, parent frustration, and unfair dynamics within the village.)
5. I will use permissible electronic devices only during appropriate times. (For example, iPods, DS systems, CD players, MP3 players and other similar devices, will only be used inside cabins during free time, unless special permission has been granted.)
6. While on trips: watches, clocks, radios or music of any kind, make-up, hair dryers, expensive dress clothes or jewelry are not necessary, and I will not bring such items, as they tend to detract from the experience.
7. I will not possess or use any illegal substance, including alcoholic beverages and/or cigarettes. I will also not vandalize any property, participate in harmful pranks, exercise any inappropriate sexual behavior, steal or attempt to steal.

In addition to the above, campers of Pioneer Village should also read and agree to the items below:

8. The Pioneer experience requires self-discipline and hard work. It is an intense group experience and I will provide 100% of my best efforts and positive attitude to it. I will also take care of myself physically and emotionally.
9. I must do my share of all daily chores, which may include getting water, cooking, cleaning, sweeping the bus, disposing of garbage, and other activities that are essential to a positive, productive, group experience.
10. My cooperation is required during our activities and trips. Therefore, I will be responsible and abide by the group’s schedule and all other aspects of the program.
